While Ridge Kids Play Care Corp. policy states that personal devices should not be used, and that televisions are not a commonly used in daycare facilities, we are requesting your consent to use a television for the following reasons:

- **Movement Breaks.** As we live in Northern Alberta and may not always be able to spend time outside, physical and gross motor activities are so valuable to a child's development. There are videos that allow them different ways of moving and learning to move such as, Danny Go! That provides them opportunities to move their bodies and coordinate, in a physical and mental manner.
- **Circle Time.** As we talk about things that interest the children, we use educational videos to allow them opportunities to learn about the things that they are interested in and new things too!
- **Brain Breaks.** Occasionally, the children enjoy the brain breaks and would you rather videos available on YouTube, to create new ways to challenge their ways of thinking.
- **Movie Time.** There are times, usually on colder days and for parties, such as Christmas party, where we invite everyone to wear their PJs, bring a stuffy and enjoy a movie in the afternoon (after lunch). These occurrences are rare but always appreciated by the children.
- **Music!!** During quiet times when children are napping and/or playing with quiet activities (sensory, puzzles, etc.) we will often put on some calm music, with a background (such as an aquarium). This allows the children some soothing sounds and an opportunity to learn about animals, places, etc.

Ridge Kids Playcare requires parents to provide a sunscreen and insect repellent, to be used on your child and kept in their cubby (labeled with their name).

Please ensure that sunscreen meets the following requirements outlined by Alberta Health:

SPF 30 and above, says “broad spectrum” that protects the skin from ultraviolet A and B (UVA and UVB) rays.

Please ensure that the insect repellent meets the guidelines outlined by Health Canada: up to 10% deet and not a replacement such as citrosa, houseplants, odor baited mosquito traps, wrist, neck or ankle bands that contain repellents, skin moisturizer, and insect repellent combination products, sunscreen and insect repellent combination products and electronic or ultrasonic devices.

In the case that parents forget or run out of sunscreen or insect repellent, the program will have approved products on site for use.
